Quorum	The trust board will agree the quorum for committee meetings. In many cases, this will be a minimum of three trustees (who are members of the committee) but may be higher.

Other curriculum issues such as spiritual, moral, social and cultural learning.7. The quality of teaching and learning throughout the trust, including performance and future performance trends and risks in relation to each academy.8. Teaching capacity throughout the trust including the impact of continuing professional development.9. How collaboration between academies in the trust and more widely is raising pupil achievement and wider outcomes.
